

Del Tura Homeowners Association April 2024 Community Survey

- Surveys gathered from 3/28 4/09
- Challenges With Survey (Disclaimer)
 - · Not a scientific survey, rather a polling of owners and residents
 - · Restricted access and limited controls impacts ability to achieve sampling desired
 - · Results may have duplicate submissions and non-resident submissions
 - · Limited access to non-HOA members restricts feedback from these residents
 - · As a result, we are only able to establish trends for potential HOA consideration
- Methods used to gather surveys
 - Single email to current HOA members with survey link
 - Post to HOA website with survey link
 - Post to HOA Facebook page
 - Multiple posts to other Del Tura Facebook pages
 - Tuesday morning coffee (4/02 & 4/09) paper-based surveys
 - Assistance by Welcome Committee to get paper survey responses
- 444 surveys received
 - 75 paper-based responses
 - 369 online responses
 - Paper surveys received with half or more questions unanswered were not included in results
- 149 surveys contained specific feedback for HOA Board (see attached)
 - Online surveys contained more comments than paper-based
 - One online comment omitted from recap as it includes personal comments about specific present/past board member
- Survey Trends Observed:
 - Enhance communication from HOA to owners (email is #1)
 - Streamline membership process (options for offline & online)
 - Remedy ticket challenges with major events (options & flexibility)
 - HOA 101 (Clarify Del Tura HOA & HTA roles & responsibilities)
 - Increase Advocacy / Influence with HTA (for all owners in Del Tura)





- I work so I can't pay the HOA is closed when I'm off work


- Just never took the time to renew. Online renewal would help.


As a current or future member of our HOA which of the following are of most interest and value to you?






Do you believe the current HOA annual fee of \$12 is?





How long have you owned a home in Del Tura?



Would you describe your time here in Del Tura as Annual or Seasonal?


